TIPS FOR SUCCESS: Please flatten all cardboard boxes. Empty and rinse all containers.

PLEASE DO NOT PLACE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN YOUR RECYCLING BIN

- Drinking glasses, window glass
- Foil wrapping paper
- Frozen food, ice cream or frozen juice containers
- Glass bottles and cups
- Hazardous or bio-hazardous waste
- Light bulbs, plates or vases
- Mirrors, ceramics or Pyrex
- Needles or syringes
- Paper ream wrappers
- Plastic microwave trays
- Plastic bags
- Plastic 6-pack holders
- Plastics other than those listed
- Scrap metal
- Shredded paper
- Styrofoam or paper to-go containers
- Tissues, paper towels, napkins
- Tyvek envelopes
- Waxed paper or waxed cardboard boxes
